NCAA Overview

- A student-athlete shall not engage in more than four seasons of intercollegiate competition in any one sport. The student-athlete shall complete their seasons of participation within five calendar years from the beginning of the semester in which the student-athlete first registered for a minimum full-time program of studies in a collegiate institution.
- For purposes of starting the count of time under the five-year rule (clock term), a student-athlete shall be considered registered at a collegiate institution when the student-athlete initially registers in a regular term of an academic year for a minimum full-time program of studies, as determined by the institution, and attends the student's first day of classes for that term.



NCAA Overview

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- During the first two years of enrollment, a student-athlete may use credits acceptable toward any of the institution's degree programs. **ALL CREDITS COUNT!**
 - By the beginning of the third year of enrollment, a student-athlete shall be required to have designated a program of studies leading toward a specific baccalaureate degree. From that point, the credits used to meet the progress-toward-degree requirements must be degree credit toward the student's designated degree program. Minor credits may be counted if the minor is required for the program.

(The tricky thing here is, what is their designated degree program?!)



First year of eligibility, Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP):

1. Must be enrolled in 12 credits each semester.
2. Must pass 6 credits each semester.
3. At the end of the year, must pass 24 credits for the academic year with no more than 6 credits completed in the summer term following this academic year.
4. At the end of the year, must meet 90% of CSU good standing GPA 2.0=1.8 cumulative GPA.



Second year (SAP):

1. Must be enrolled in 12 credits each semester.
2. Must pass 6 credits each semester.
3. At the end of the year, must pass 18 credits for the academic year per NCAA rule. CSU rule is 24 credits with no more than 6 credits completed in the summer term following this academic year.
4. At the end of the year, must meet 95% of CSU good standing GPA 2.0=1.9 cumulative GPA.



Second Year Degree Percentage:

- A student-athlete who is entering their third year of collegiate enrollment shall have completed successfully at least 40% of the course requirements in the student's specific degree program. This is 48 credits for most programs.
- If a student got behind in their first year because all credits could count, they need to catch up here. By the first day of classes in their third year, they must meet this requirement in the major they are enrolled in on that day.



Third year (SAP):

1. Must be enrolled in 12 credits each semester.
2. Must pass 6 credits each semester.
3. At the end of the year, must pass 18 credits for the academic year per NCAA rule. CSU rule is 24 credits with no more than 6 credits completed in the summer term following this academic year.
4. At the end of the year, must meet 100% of CSU good standing GPA 2.0=2.0 cumulative GPA.



Third Year Degree Percentage:

- A student-athlete who is entering their fourth year of collegiate enrollment shall have completed successfully at least 60% of the course requirements in the student's specific degree program. This is 72 credits for most programs.



Fourth Year (SAP):

1. Must be enrolled in 12 credits each semester.
2. Must pass 6 credits each semester.
3. At the end of the year, must pass 18 credits for the academic year per NCAA rule. CSU rule is 24 credits with no more than 6 credits completed in the summer term following this academic year.
4. At the end of the year, must meet 100% of CSU good standing GPA 2.0=2.0 cumulative GPA.



Fourth Year Degree Percentage:

- A student-athlete who is entering their fifth year of collegiate enrollment shall have completed successfully at least 80% of the course requirements in the student's specific degree program. This is 96 credits for most programs.

Exception to 12 credits:

- In a student-athlete's last semester, they may file for a waiver to the 12 credit hour rule if they need less than 12 hours to complete their degree.
- Form filled out by academic department for all majors and minors. Final signoff is from the Registrar's Office.
- If approved, Athletics notifies the RO so that we can enter an Exception in DARwin to show that student needs less than 12 credits for that term.



Changes of Major:

- **Change of Major After Completion of Academic Year:**

A student-athlete who changes his/her designated degree program after the completion of the academic year may comply with NCAA progress toward degree requirements if (a) the credits earned prior to the change are acceptable toward the degree previously sought; and (b) the credits earned from the time of the change are acceptable toward the new degree.

- **Change of Major During Semester Break:**

If a student-athlete changes his/her major at semester break, the fall semester will be evaluated based on satisfactory progress in the old major. The spring semester and academic year will be evaluated based on the new major.

- **Change of Major During the Semester:**

If a student, in accordance with institutional policy, changes his/her major during a semester, the degree credits earned during that term can be applied toward the degree previously sought or toward the new degree.

- **Change of Major during Summer Term:**

An athlete cannot change their major during the summer term and have a course for that program be counted towards satisfactory progress (SAP) for the past year. They must meet 24 credits towards their major from spring (unless they changed their major from fall to spring, then it would be whatever counted in fall for the major that term and whatever counted in spring for the major that term). However, change can be used for degree percentage requirements.



Bowl Game:

- A student-athlete's eligibility shall be determined within 14 business days (regardless of the date in which grades are posted or submitted) after the date of the last scheduled exam listed in the institution's official calendar for the term that is ending.
- If the postseason event occurs prior to the conclusion of the 14 business days, eligibility shall be determined by using grades from the immediately preceding regular academic term (e.g. fall term if certifying for a bowl game), provided a sufficient number of grades from the term have been posted. All grades posted in accordance with institutional procedures by 5 p.m. local time on the day prior to the postseason event must be considered.
- If the postseason event occurs prior to the conclusion of the 14 business days and an insufficient number of grades from the immediately preceding term have been posted, eligibility shall be determined by using grades from the most recent regular academic term for which a sufficient number of grades have been posted.



Calendar of Events:

- September, week after census:
 - Produce list of current athletes and e-mail to Athletics.
- December:
 - Receive squad lists and certification lists from Athletics.
 - Update athletic database by adding or deleting athletes for the year.
 - If invited to a bowl game, produce list of football athletes after grades.
 - Produce list of all current athletes after grades and e-mail to Athletics.
- February, week after census:
 - Produce list of current athletes and e-mail to Athletics.
- April:
 - GRS/IPEDS Report should start being worked on (due June 1st).
 - Process our data and provide to Institutional Research for entry into website.
 - Verify data entered.



Calendar, cont.:

- May:
 - Produce list of all current athletes after grades and e-mail to Athletics.
 - Produce list of athletes that have not met 24 credits SAP and e-mail to Athletics.
 - Send notification letters to unsatisfactory SAP athletes.
- May – August:
 - Receive appeal forms for unsatisfactory SAP athletes.
 - Watch for CSU grades, incoming transfer transcripts, grade changes, etc. in order to clear appeals.
 - Send letters to athletes that have met their appeal.
 - Update athletic database with S (Satisfactory) or U (Unsatisfactory) for each athlete.
 - Run report of all athletes that enrolled for summer and update yearly report.

- **Off the Field...**

General George Armstrong Custer was killed along with two-hundred sixty-four Union Cavalry troopers after engaging the Sioux tribe at Little Big Horn. Not realizing the overwhelming numerical superiority of the Native Americans, the 7th Cavalry had made a crucial tactical error by dividing their forces into three separate divisions. A Civil War hero, Custer had fought at the first battle of Bull Run, distinguished himself in both the Peninsular campaign as well as Gettysburg and was selected as the Union officer to receive the Confederate flag of truce at Appomattox Courthouse.

- **In the National League...**

The National League of Professional Baseball was formed with an eight-team circuit consisting of the Boston Red Stockings, Chicago White Stockings, Cincinnati Red Legs, Hartford Dark Blues, Louisville Grays, Philadelphia Athletics, Brooklyn Mutuals and St. Louis Browns. All owners agreed to play a seventy game schedule between April 22 and October 21.


